Parts Listing

1. Four main floors

- A. Base Floor with markings S1 thru S6
- B. 1st Floor with markings 1A thru 1H
- C. 2nd Floor with markings 2A thru 2H note no wall
- 2. First floor walls 1A thru 1H
- 3. 2nd floor walls 2A thru 2H
- 4. 3rd floor wall 3A thru 3H, NO 3F for kit assembly
- 5. Walls T1 thru T4
- 6. 6 window assemblies with plexiglas
- 7. 9 round window assemblies with plexiglas
- 8. 2 sets of round door trim
- 9. 1 main door assembly
- 10. 4 interior door assemblies
- 11. 2 sets of houseworks stairs (except in 1:48 scale) stairs are from Laser Dollhouse designs LDD
- 12. 2 stair rail assemblies
- 13. 1 porch step assembly
- 14. 8 porch post hand carved by LDD
- 15. 2 angled and 4 straight porch rails
- 16. 1 long and 6 short upper porch running trim.
- 17. 2 porch roof assemblies, 1 gazebo with 8 supports and 8 roof panels, 1 center roof with two support angles and one panel

- 18. 6 lower tower corbels
- 19. 3 upper tower corbels
- 20. 4 lower tower extensions
- 21. 4 upper tower extensions
- 22. 3 chimney assemblies

Note : Highly recommend dry assembly (NO GLUE) prior to actual assembly to familiarize with parts and locations. Use masking tape to hold together. Only assembly of house shell required. After assembly verify other parts such as rails, window frames, plexiglas, doors, ect.

Step 1. Locate parts for window assembly, Prior to assembly and gluing together recommend completing painting.

Parts should be: 1. three (3) upper window Gingerbread headpieces.

- 2. (1) main window frame
- 3. (1) interior Window frame
- 4. Two (2) upper window supports for gingerbread

frames marked bottom and top

- 5. (1) lower window frame
- 6. Six (6) large corbels
- 7. Six (6) small corbels



Step 2. Install (6) large corbels to the main window frame Each slot fits (2) corbels. Figure 2


Step 3. Install lower and upper gingerbread support rails above large corbels, one marked bottom goes in first and top sits above. Figure 3



Step 4. Install three (3) gingerbread frames into the installed upper window supports. The three should make up one layer once installed. Carefully work into place and set flush

Step 5. Install lower window frame, figure 5

Step 6. Install Six (6) small corbels in lower slots, each slot install (2) corbels. Figure 6.

Step 7. Install completed window frames onto wall later in assembly.Each outer area is marked for reference location and centering.Figure 7. Installed window within wall markings, figure 8.

Step 8. Install glass later in open wall cutouts and interior frame to hold in place, figure 9. Install interior frames by aligning through opening with exterior frame.



Step 1. Locate base floor marked S1 thru S6, install support rails marked S1 thru S6 by matching numbered parts to numbered location on base floor. Insert support rail tabs into base slots. See figure 1.

Step 2. Install 1st floor base on top of base frames. Figure 2. If gluing house use masking tape to hold floors together. Remove once glue is dry. If doing dry assembly apply tape to hold together and proceed with assembly.





Step 3. Install walls 1A thru 1H, if gluing install windows and doors prior to walls. Figure 3

Step 4. Install 2nd floor onto 1st floor walls. If gluing DO NOT glue this floor till you completed wallpaper and interior of 1st floor. Install 2nd floor and leave for glue to dry. Once dry remove and work on interior walls and floors. Once done glue floor. Note check for alignment by placing second floor on during wallpapering to assure wall did not move during work.

Note: If doing dry assembly proceed to step 15.

Step 5. assemble stairs with rails to the left side by following instructions in the Houseworks package, once stairs are dry install to the house with top landing flush to floor. Figure 5 If doing dry assembly skip to installing 2nd floor walls.

Step 6. Stall two (2) newel posts aligned with edge of floor cutout. Assemble upper rail using (7) spindles, one upper and one lower handrail.figure 6



Step 7. assemble rear rails as you did for side rail using the smaller rails and four (4) spindles. Figure 7 Make sure you again are aligned with floor opening and do not go into the path of where wall 2C will be installed.





Step 8. Stairs and rails are completed and should look like figure 8.



Step 9. Install Corner post using drawn square on floor as guide, figure 9

Step 10. Install center long upper running trim. Tab fits to upper floor. Figure 10 also install next post again using drawn square on porch and upper rail as guide.

Step 11. Assemble porch rails, make (4) with straight rails and (2) with angled rails. Figure 11

Step 12. Install one straight porch rail to lower post and one upper porch running trim. Figure 12

Step 13. Install next post and glue to upper and lower rail and floors. Weight down from top and let dry. Figure 13

Step 14. Install angled rails to post corner and upper trim, figure 14. Continue process with remaining post and rails applying one set at a time till completed, figure 15







Step 15. Install 2nd floor door and windows to walls and install wall to 2nd floor. Figure 16





Step 16. Install 3rd floor base to top o 2nd floor walls. Follow same procedures for doing interior and wallpaper as earlier. Figure 17

Step 17. Install porch gazebo roof supports (8), figure 19 make sure the one with a short tip is place on the left side against wall 2F, figure 18

Step 18. locate the three roof pieces that are trimmed, apply the first with a tip against wall 2F, figure 20. Apply the one with the bottom ends trimmed to the back corner, figure 21. Finally install the remaining with one end trimmed to the back, figure 22.

Step 19. Install remaining gazebo roofs. Figure 23 Center and apply a small amount of glue in between cracks, work in with finger and let dry. Later you may apply wood filler if desired.

Step 24. Install far left outer roof panel, figure 28



Step 27. Install left roof inner roof panel and tape each side together and let dry, figure 31.



Step 28. Align and glue together flush the edge of wall 3E and left inner roof panel. Tape together flush while drying. Figure 32



Step 36. Install tower base extensions make sure the (5) slot plates are in front.



Step 37. Install (6) tower base corbels, figure 41. Note kit has (9) all together, ensure you match the six and separate the three larger ones of the nine, they will be use later on top of tower roof.

Step 39. Install tower walls T1 thru T4, figure 43 Once you have all 4 tower walls into the tower floor pull together and align the walls. Tape together and install tower lower roof, figure 44.



Step 44. Install 22 wall corbels around the second floor upper wall. Each opening insert two corbels, figure 49.

Step 45. Install tower running trim, figure 50.







Step 46. Assemble chimney, align outer walls and glue, figure 51. At top install chimney locking covers as in figure 52.

Step 47. Install chimney on support chimney base, figure 53 & 54. Next press and align against walls and slide over roof, figure 55. Make sure chimney is carefully set between floor notches and is flush with walls, figure 56. Clamp and let dry.

Fireplace Assembly

Note: you may assemble in or out of house, as long as everything is glued aligned it will be fine during install.

Step 48. Take fireplace base and install into bottom of wall. Figure 57

Step 49. Install on fireplace face, two face plates, figure 58

Step 50. Install fireplace outer walls by inserting into wall and fireplace base, figure 59

Fireplace Assembly

Step 51. Install fireplace front assembly, make sure that the front and sides are aligned, figure 60

Step 52. Install inside three walls by aligning into wall and inside edges, figure 61.

Step 53. Install fireplace upper wall, figure 62

Step 54. Glue together the three small dowels to make fireplace logs and install into assembled fireplace, figure 63.

Step 55. Complete assembly for remaining two fireplace assemblies and install, figure 64.

Front Porch stair Assembly

NOTE: Highly recommend <u>NOT</u> using superglue for stairs as you have to align properly!!!!

Step 56. Apply masking tape to stair support on bottom side and apply glue along tape, figure 65. Next slide and align the large outer cut slots to front porch post, use the stair handrails and check alignment, figure 66 & 67. Next install stair handrails and step supports in center, figure 68.

Step 57. Install square dowels in front of there center supports, figure 69. Continue with last two placing on top of three center supports to form steps, figure 70. Press from the sides and align. Allow to glue to dry.

Step 58. Install two post aligning with porch post, figure 71.
